The Journal of Military Aviation History is a new journal, and we would like for you to be a part of it! We welcome submissions covering the history of military aviation from all geographic regions and eras. Our mission is to preserve all aspects of the history of military aviation, and we encourage article submissions in biography, engineering, manufacturing, training, combat operations, policy and staff studies, and any subject related to military aviation across the globe at any time in history.

- Each article will be 8,000 to 9,000 words in length.
- The author will submit one digital copy of the manuscript in Word (.DOC or .DOCX) format.
- Place your name and contact information on a separate title page. Place no identifying information on any page of your article submission. The editorial staff will remove the title page and place it in your file. The manuscript without any identifying marks will be submitted to a double-blind referee system.
- All submissions should be emailed to the editor at: vwilliams@acu.edu with JMAH MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION noted in the subject line.
- All manuscripts should be created using the Chicago Manual of Style. Use double spacing, footnotes, tables (if needed), and a justified right hand margin.

Once a recommendation is received from the two referees, the editor will make the final decision and notify the author.
